Great Park CEO retires

Marty Bryant has been on the job since January

Great Park CEO Marty Bryant announced his retirement Wednesday.

Bryant, who took the helm of the Great Park Corp. in January, will step down June 15 after more than 20 years with the city of Irvine.

Marsha Burgess, a spokeswoman for the Great Park Corp., said Bryant is stepping down due to health issues.

City manager Sean Joyce said a search for an interim CEO will begin immediately; recruitment of a permanent leader will start soon after.

A former director of public works, Bryant headed the effort to get approval for the \$50-million project to lower Jeffrey Road under the train tracks just south of Walnut Avenue.
