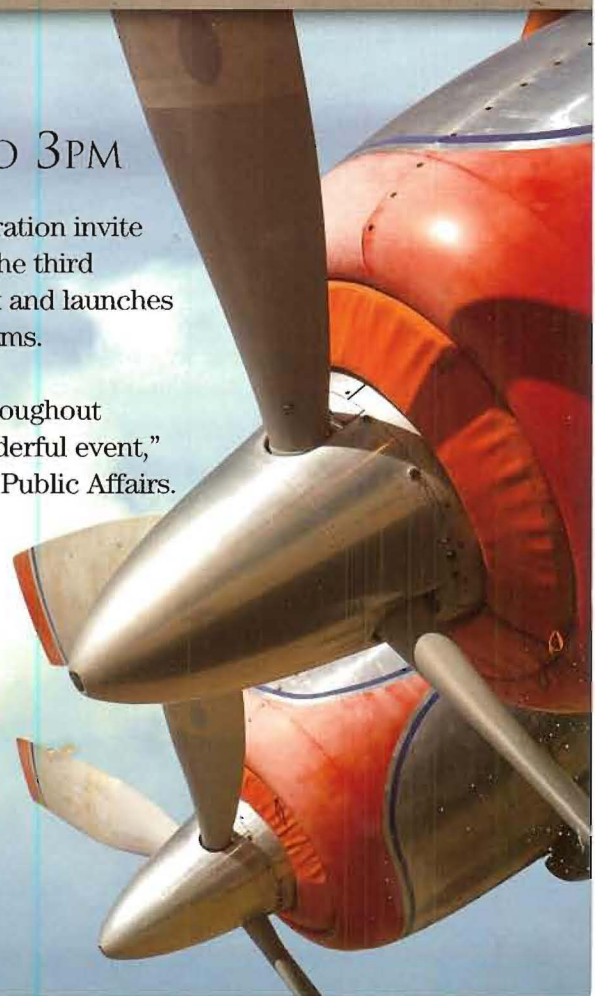

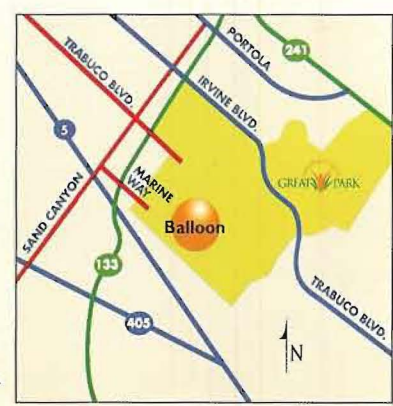

- From the 5 Freeway heading South**
- Exit Jeffrey Rd. and turn right on Walnut Ave.
 - Turn right on Jeffrey Rd.
 - Turn right on Trabuco Rd. and continue straight past Sand Canyon Ave.
 - Follow signs to Event Parking

- From the 5 Freeway heading North**
- Exit Sand Canyon Ave. and turn right
 - Turn left on Marine Way
 - Turn left after the stop sign
 - Follow signs to Event Parking

- From the 405 Freeway heading South**
- Exit Shady Canyon Dr./Sand Canyon Ave. and turn left on Sand Canyon Ave.
 - Turn right on Marine Way
 - Turn left after the stop sign
 - Follow signs to Event Parking
