When you fly aloft in our **Great Park Balloon**, you will be able to see the Park grow before your eyes.

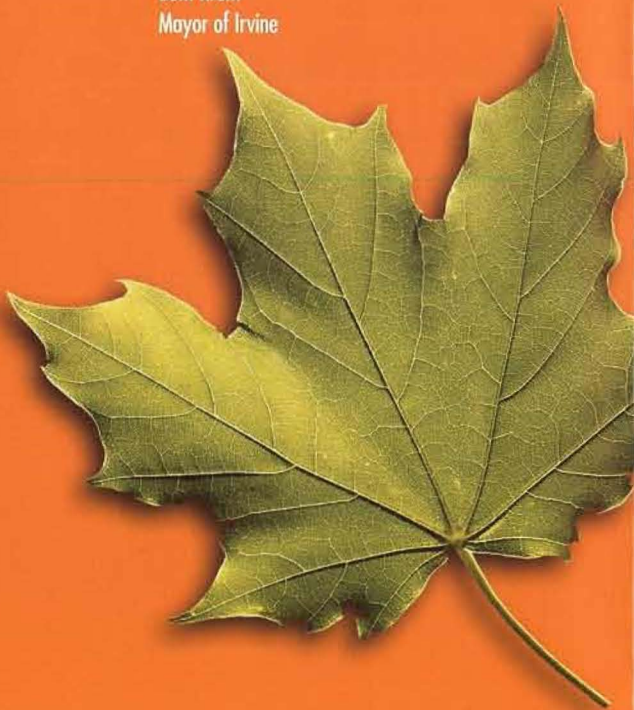

Throughout the summer, you will be able to enjoy concerts and performances that will preview the entertainment opportunities that will be found in the future Great Park.



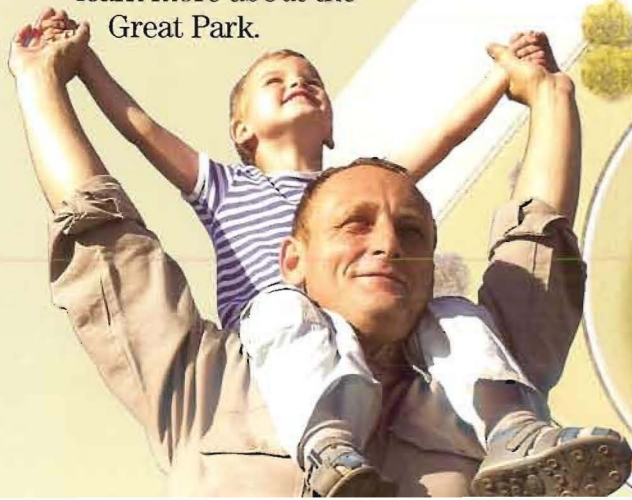
3 The Hangar Café

7 The Picnic Lawn

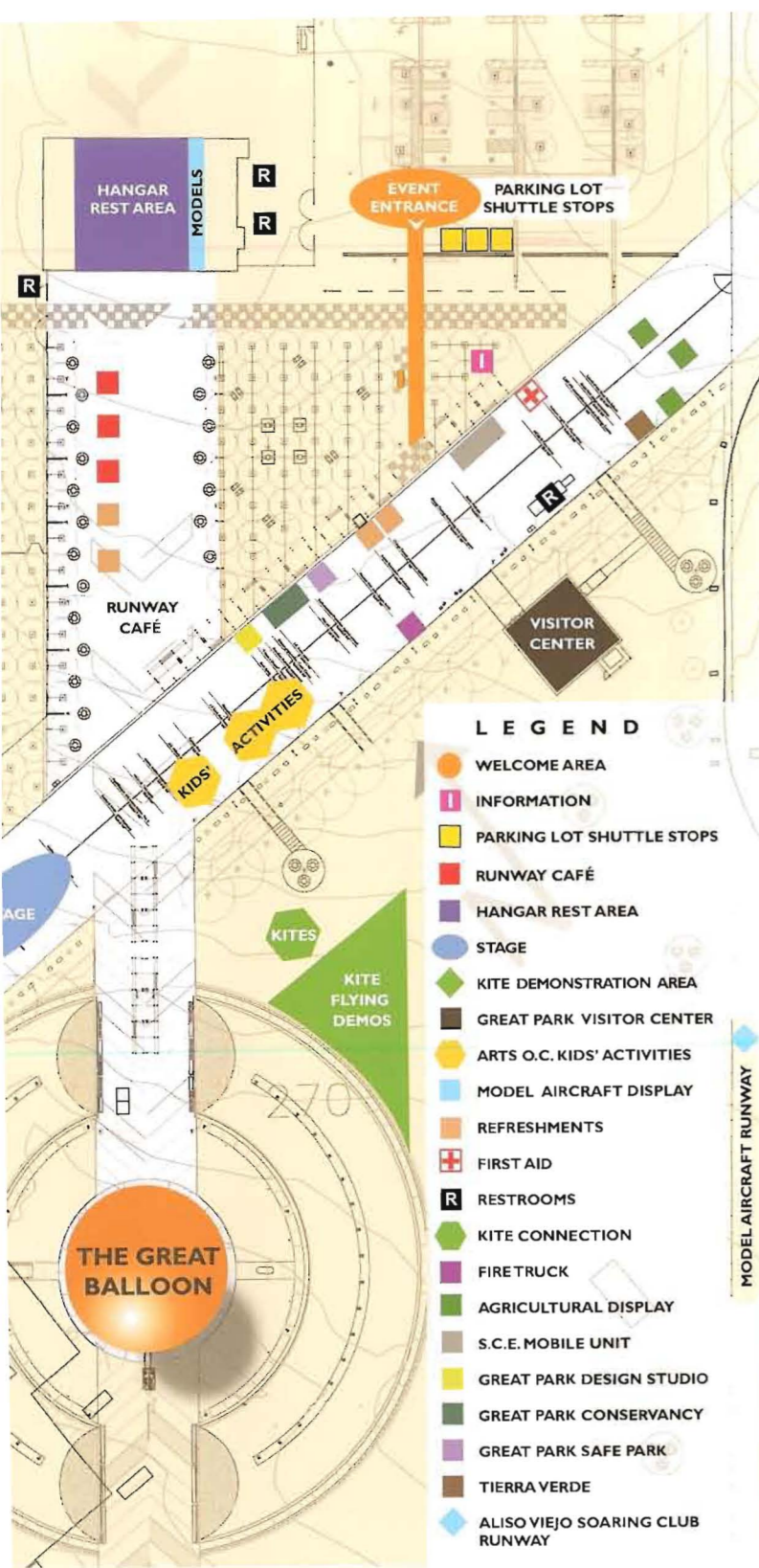
Have a picnic, play frisbee, kick a soccer ball around or just relax on the 3-acre Picnic Lawn adjacent to the balloon.

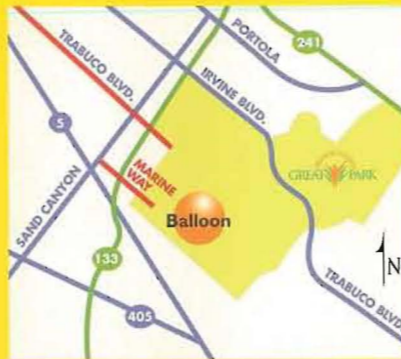

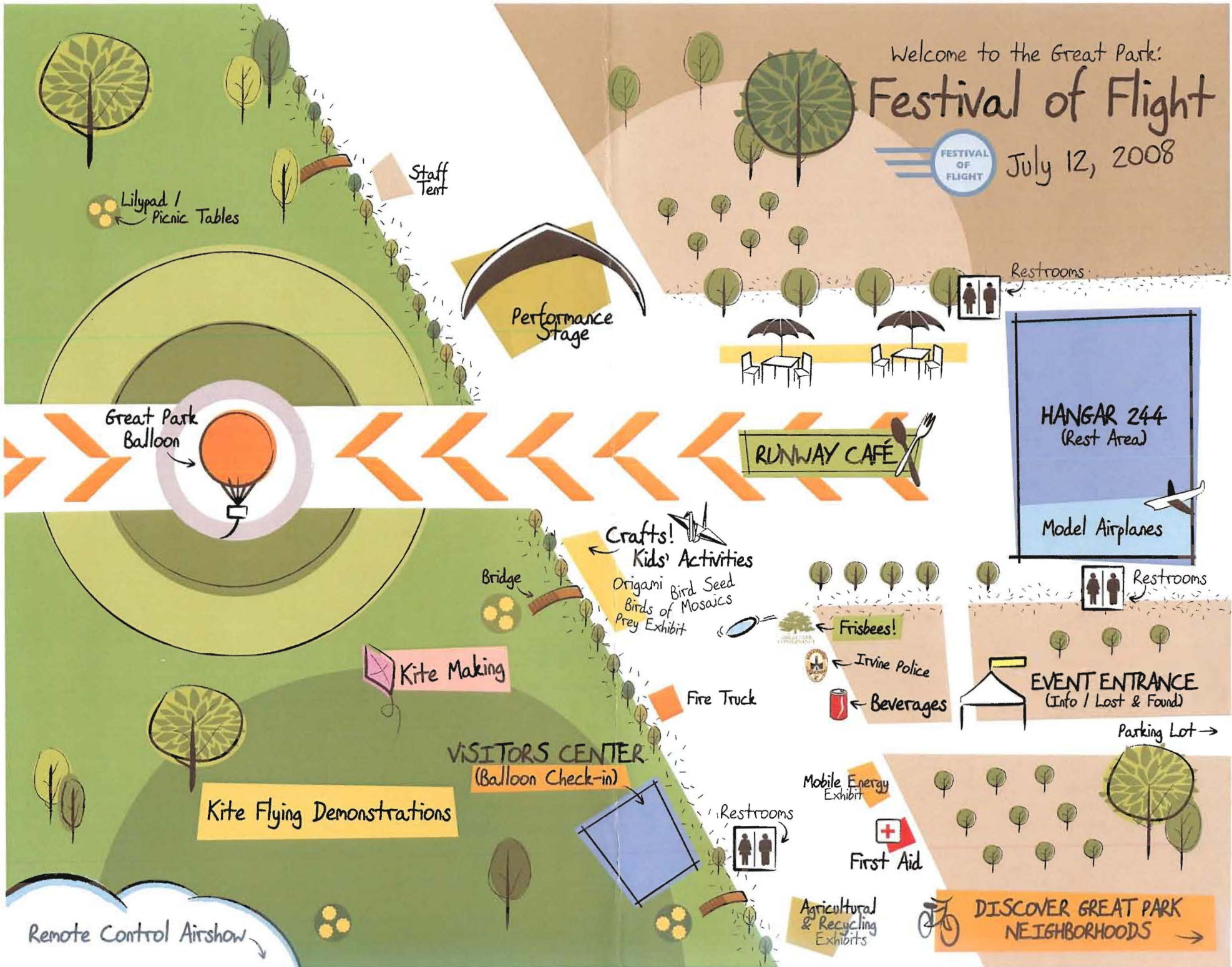
