Great Park could postpone CEO search

Board meets Thursday.

The Great Park staff plans to recommend that the search for a chief executive be postponed until January.

The Great Park board will meet at 10 a.m. Thursday at City Hall.

A five-year business plan will be presented in a study session, and the board will review programs that are being studied the next phase of design, such as badminton courts, camping sites, a farmer's market, nature trails and park transportation.

The board will plan for summer events, including a possible partnership with the Irvine Barclay Theatre. Programs could include

- Festival of Flight on July 12 at the preview park
- Night flights of the passenger balloon
- A Hangar Café in August to September
- A photography exhibition August to October
- An oral history participants' reunion Oct. 2
- A teen focused program Oct. 11
- Pumpkin decorating and haunted hangar Oct. 25.
